Our Strategy

From believers to disciple-making disciples

We believe God is calling us to intentionally equip and train people of Coro for gospel ministry. Ephesians 4 tells us Jesus poured out His gifts on the apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastor and teachers in order *to equip the saints for ministry*.

Outwardly focused

We want to build on the foundation of strong worship services, and to allow these to fuel us for active service in the world. We have one life as the beloved of God to make an impact for the kingdom of God through our witness to others. Jesus, the Lord of the universe, loves His Church and we are the only ones He sends into a lost and broken world with His healing, saving, life changing-gospel. We want to equip you to do that in the particular way the Spirit of God is calling you.

Intentionally Equipping the Saints

We will do this in several ways:

1) **The 'Building a Discipling Culture' process.**

'Building a Discipling Culture' is a discipleship coaching process for congregations. See www.bdc.org.au. It will begin with 8 leaders chosen by council who will then coach others. Through work in cluster groups we will be coached with tools, practices and skills for imitating the life and ministry of Jesus. "These tools are simple, memorable and reproducible, allowing them to be passed along from generation to generation".

2) **Intentional outward focus.**

We are planning new initiatives to encourage us to be outward-looking in both proclaiming the gospel to unbelievers and showing God's deep love for those who face injustice and powerlessness in many forms. One initiative is a series of seminars focused on practical equipping in areas such as 'Evangelism', 'Justice', 'Work' and 'Culture.'

3) **The employment of a discipleship pastor.**

To intentionally focus on equipping, supporting and training throughout our ministries. This person would also take a lead in overseeing and strengthening our Life Groups ministry.

4) **The continued employment of a youth pastor.**

Supporting and equipping our young people for gospel living and leadership.

(These two roles will be the equivalent of 1 full time position. They may be combined for the right person or be two .5 positions)

In order to achieve our vision, we will need to increase our funds by 38% This is comprised of 21% to maintain current expenses and 17% to meet the increase.
